The Harvard Conservation Commission will conduct a virtual public hearing under Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 131, Section 40, The Wetland Protection Act and the Code of the Town of Harvard, Chapter 119, Harvard Wetland Bylaw, on **Thursday, April 1, 2021**, at 8:15 p.m. on a Notice of Intent filed on behalf of the Harvard Department of Public Works for the replacement of traffic safety features and minor patching along the substructure within the resource area and its 100' riverfront area at the bridge crossing of Bower's Brook between 6 and 22 Old Mill Road, Harvard.
