## PUBLIC HEARING

The Harvard Conservation Commission will conduct a virtual public hearing under Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 131, Section 40, The Wetland Protection Act and the Code of the Town of Harvard, Chapter 119, Harvard Wetland Bylaw, on **Thursday, May 6, 2021**, at 8:45 p.m. on a Notice of Intent filed on behalf of Alma Gregory and Kristiina Sorensen for the replacement of existing steps and railings with new stairs and deck platform, the addition of boulder steps, stone pavers, landscape walls, new landscaping throughout, extension of an existing shed, removal of nine trees and replacing the existing dock with a bigger prefab pier structure within 200' of Bare Hill Pond at 23 Peninsula Road, Harvard.
