Proposed Protective Bylaw Amendments 2023 Special Town Meeting

The Harvard Planning Board will hold a virtual public hearing pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 40A, Section 5, on **Monday, Nov. 28, 2022**, at 7 p.m.. to consider and receive comments from interested parties concerning proposed amendments to Chapter 125 of the Code of the Town of Harvard, the Protective Bylaw, to be considered at the 2023 Special Town Meeting, with a date to be determined in early 2023.
