Proposed Protective Bylaw Amendment

The Harvard Planning Board will hold a virtual public hearing pursuant to Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 40A, Section 5, on Monday, July 17, 2023, at 7:30 p.m. to consider and receive comments from interested parties concerning a proposed amendment to Chapter 125 of the Code of the Town of Harvard, the Protective Bylaw to be considered at the 2023 Fall Town Meeting, on Saturday, Oct. 21, 2023.
