The Harvard Conservation Commission will conduct a virtual public hearing under Massachusetts General Laws Chapter 131, Section 40, The Wetland Protection Act and the Code of the Town of Harvard, Chapter 119, Harvard Wetland Protection Bylaw, on **Thursday, Oct. 19, 2023**, at 8:15 p.m. on an Abbreviated Notice of Intent filed on behalf of Harvard Conservation Trust for an invasives plant removal, native plant re-introduction, and wildlife habitat restoration within the 100' wetland buffer zone on the Coke-Newsham land (Map 17B Parcel 31, 32 & 38) on Whitney & Littleton Roads, Harvard.
